- **With what ?**
Find out about land and air means on site and in transit

Phase 2

- **Ambient message**

Acquisition of operational data by reconnaissance:

- **Analysis of the situation**
- **Predictable development**

- **Immediate reactions**

Initial operation order **S.A.O.I.E.C**

- **C.O.S code + name of the municipality**
- **Welcome reinforcements (transit point)**
- **Continue recognition**

- **Where ? / By where ?**
Welcome, physical or radio contact
- **Against what ?**
I assess the development of the fire, I prepare a mission for reinforcements
- **How ?**
I contact reinforcements and I transmit the SOIEC
- **With what ?**
All the reinforcements

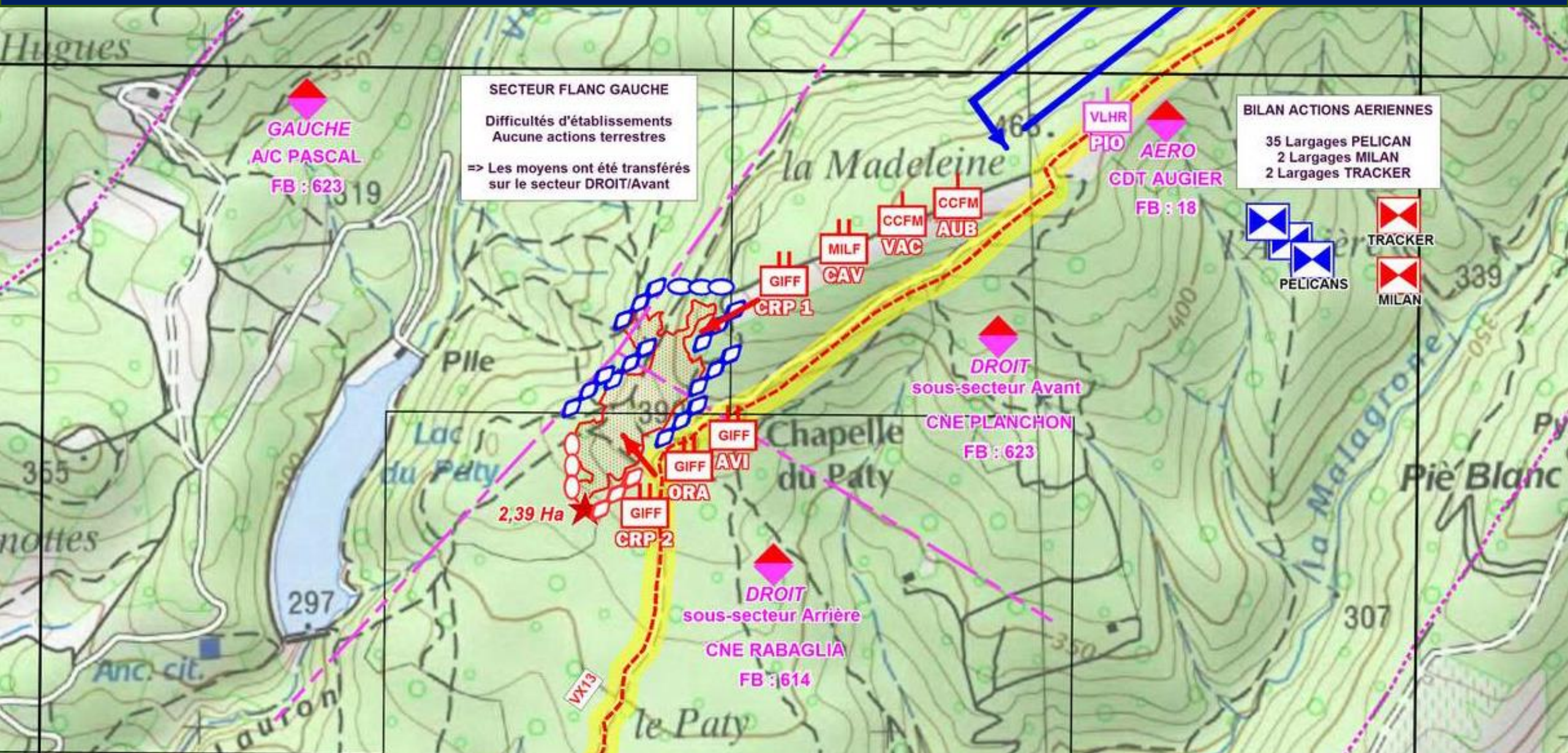
