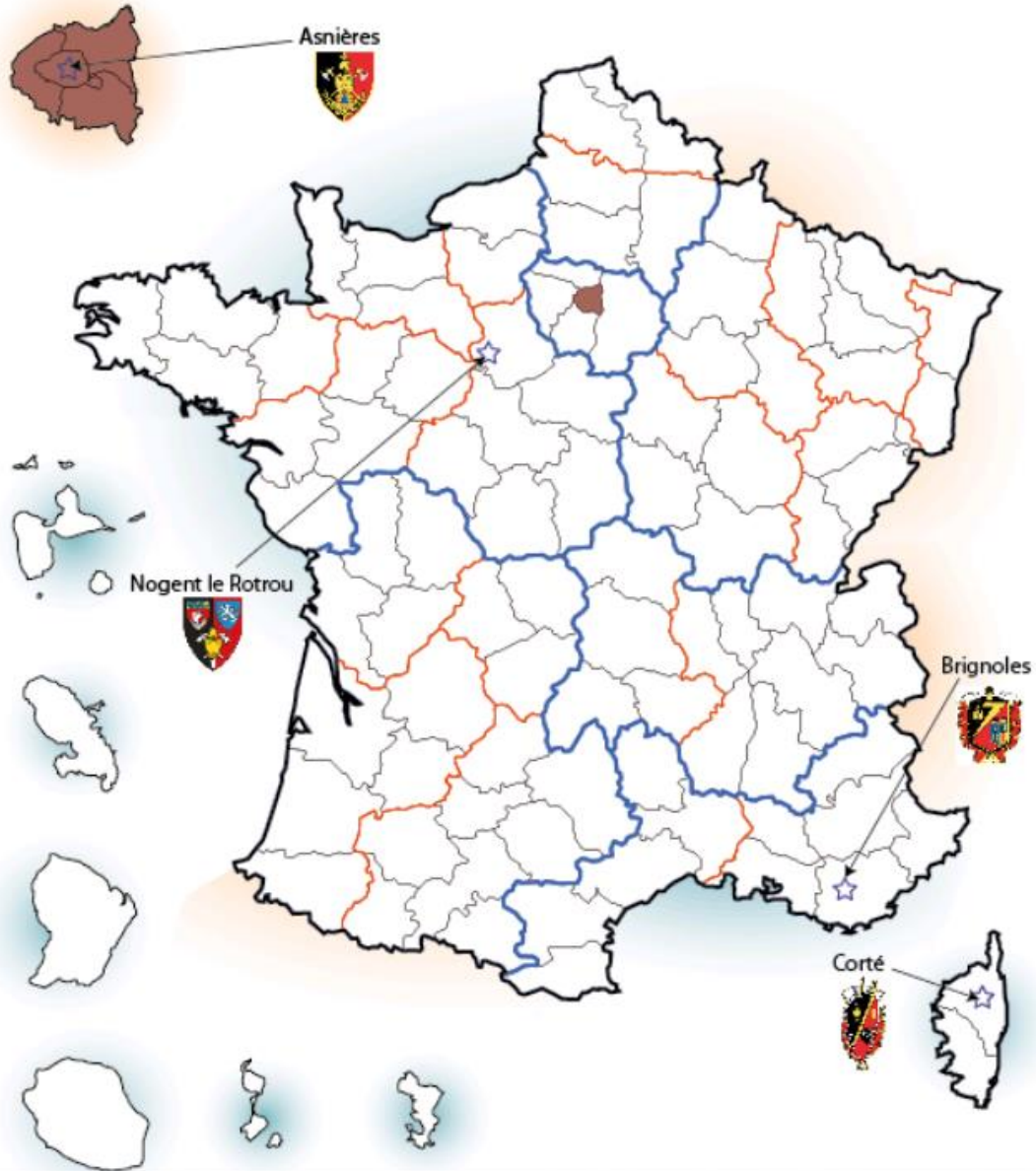

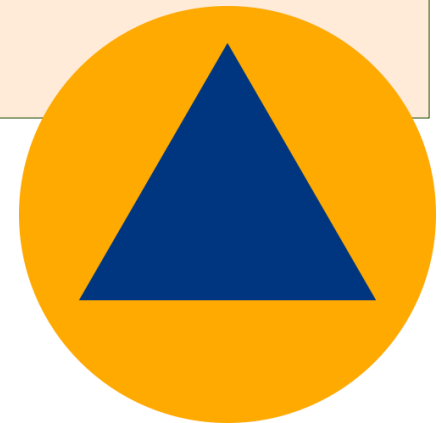

CIVIL SECURITY INTERVENTION AND TRAINING UNITS



Civil security training and intervention units (UIISC) are French firefighting and rescue units with military operations.

The UIISC rescuers are operational 7 days a week and 24 hours a day. These units number approximately 1,500 men and are placed under the organic authority of the commander of the military formations of civil security (COMFORMISC) and under the operational authority of the General Directorate of Civil Security and Crisis Management (DGSCGC) which reports to the Ministry of the Interior.

Detachement Intervention Retardant Delayed Intervention Detachment

The DIR are intended to participate in the creation of support lines or the protection of sensitive points and, occasionally, in offensive actions using the use of retardant additives.

Features :

- 1 VLHR
- 3 CCFS 6000 liters
- 1 pioneer vehicle
- 1 retardant manufacturing unit



LE GAP

Groupe Appui Support Group

The support detachments are intended to create tracks, firebreaks, enhance a support line or treat a controlled edge.



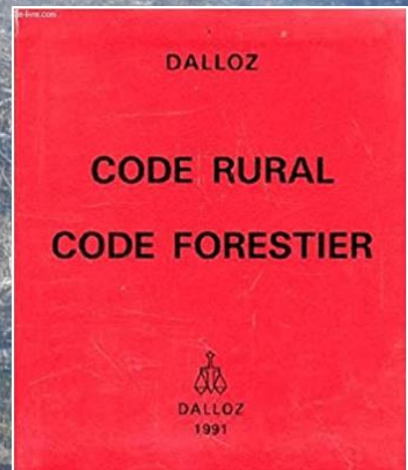
Features :

- 300 m in 1 hour or 1 km in 1 day
- 2 tractor levelers
- 1 Protection group

Two techniques are used when implementing tactical fires:

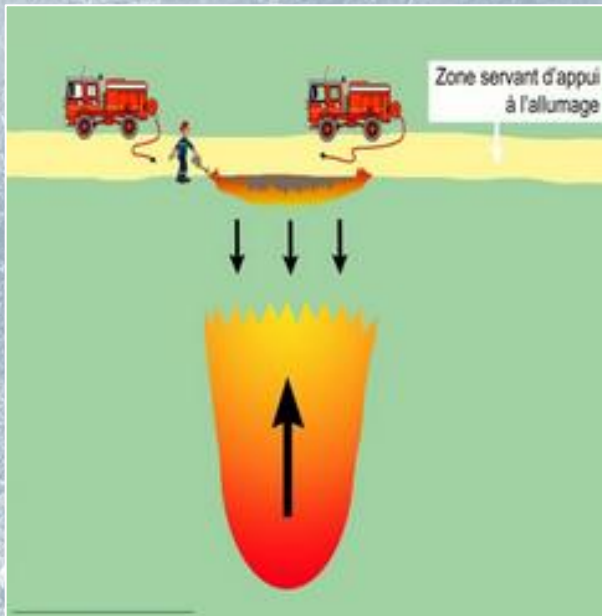
- counter-fire
- tactical burning.



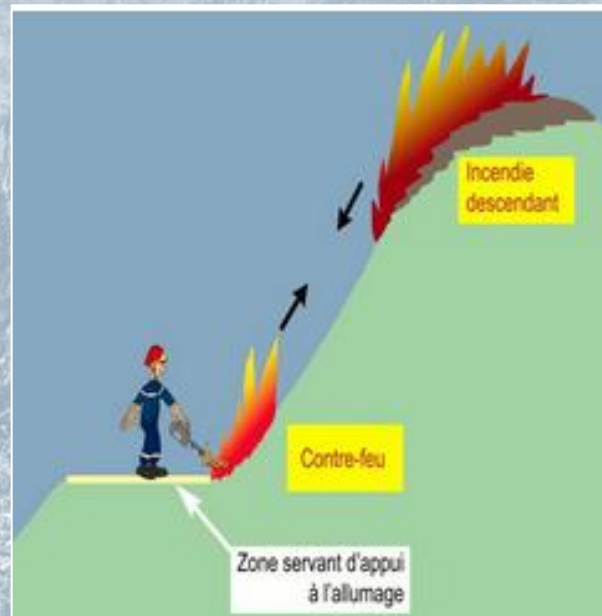
TACTICAL LIGHTS

The counter-fire

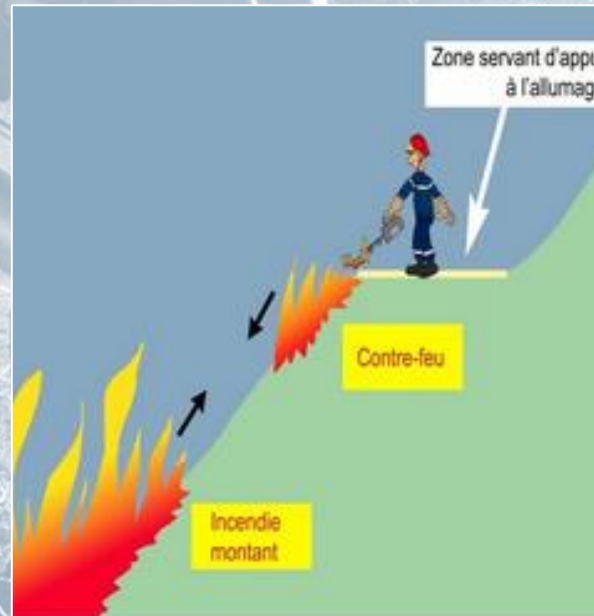
The flat counter-fire



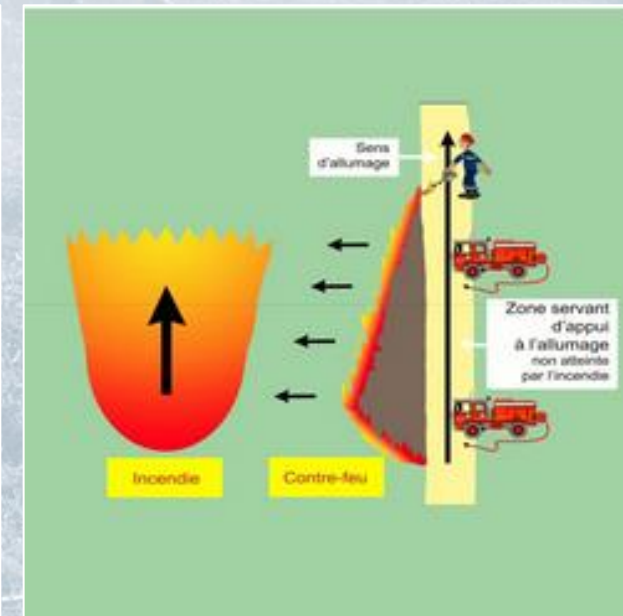
The rising counter-fire



The descending counterfire

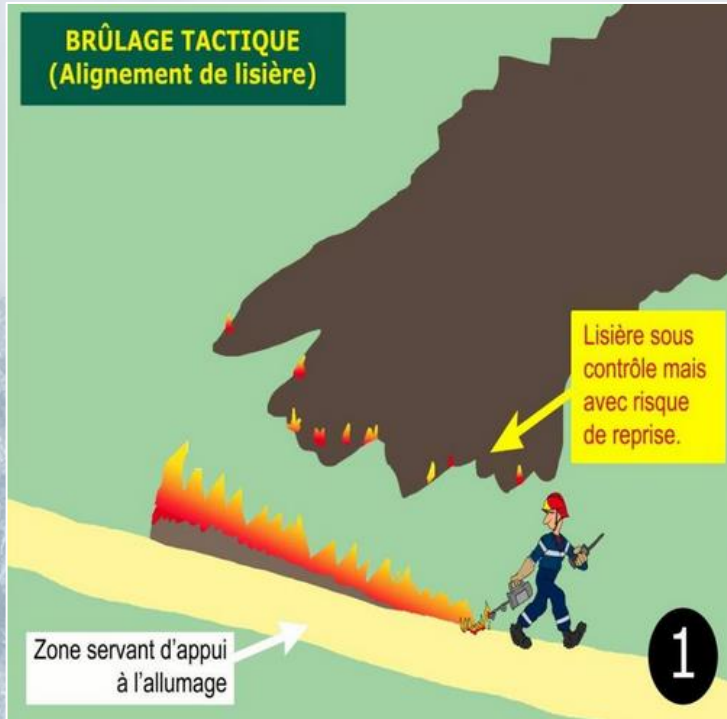


The side counterfire

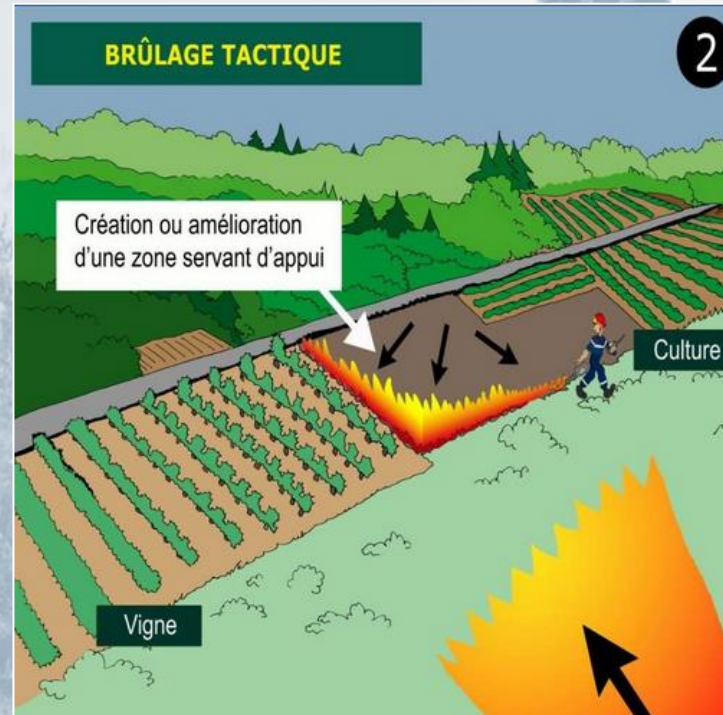


TACTICAL LIGHTS

Tactical burning



turn off a partially active edge or one that presents risks of recovery



facilitate the creation or improvement of an area serving as support for the fight, the creation of a fallback zone for the safety of personnel or protect the perimeter of a sensitive point.
